Indian Constitution?

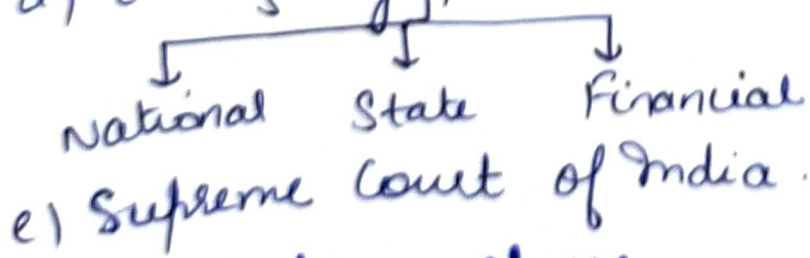
Since, no constitution in the world can

1) Govt. of India act 1935

- a) Administrative structure of Centre & State
- b) office of Governor in every State
- c) Idea of federalism
- d) Emergency provisions



2) Constitution of US

- a) Preamble
- b) Fundamental rights
- c) Equal protection of law
- d) Independence of Judiciary
- e) Judicial review

f) vice president would be Chairman of Rajya Sabha.

3) Britain

- Parliamentary form of Govt
- Single citizenship i.e. only citizenship of India
- Rule of law i.e. law above all.
- Office of Comptroller & Auditor General
- Writ (Command)

4) Ireland

- DPSP
- President election procedure.

5) Canada

- Federation with strong centres
- Residual power - headed by Parliament

6) Germany

- Emergency provisions lie in Central Govt
- Suspension of fundamental rights during emergency

7) Australia

- Cooperative federalism & Concurrent list.
