

# Schedules of Indian Constitution Palak Mahajan

Initially there were 8 Schedules, later with amendments 4 more Schedules have been added to the Constitution.

1<sup>st</sup> Schedule :- It contains name of States & UTs.  
- Territorial Jurisdiction of State i.e. territorial limit in which the law is applicable.

2<sup>nd</sup> Schedule :- It consists of provisions in relation with allowances, privileges, emoluments of President, Governance of Indian State, Speaker & Deputy Speaker of Lok Sabha, Chairman & Deputy Chairman of Rajya Sabha, Speaker & Deputy Speaker of Legislative Assembly, Chairman & Deputy Chairman of Legislative Council, Supreme Court & High Court Judges, CAG of India.

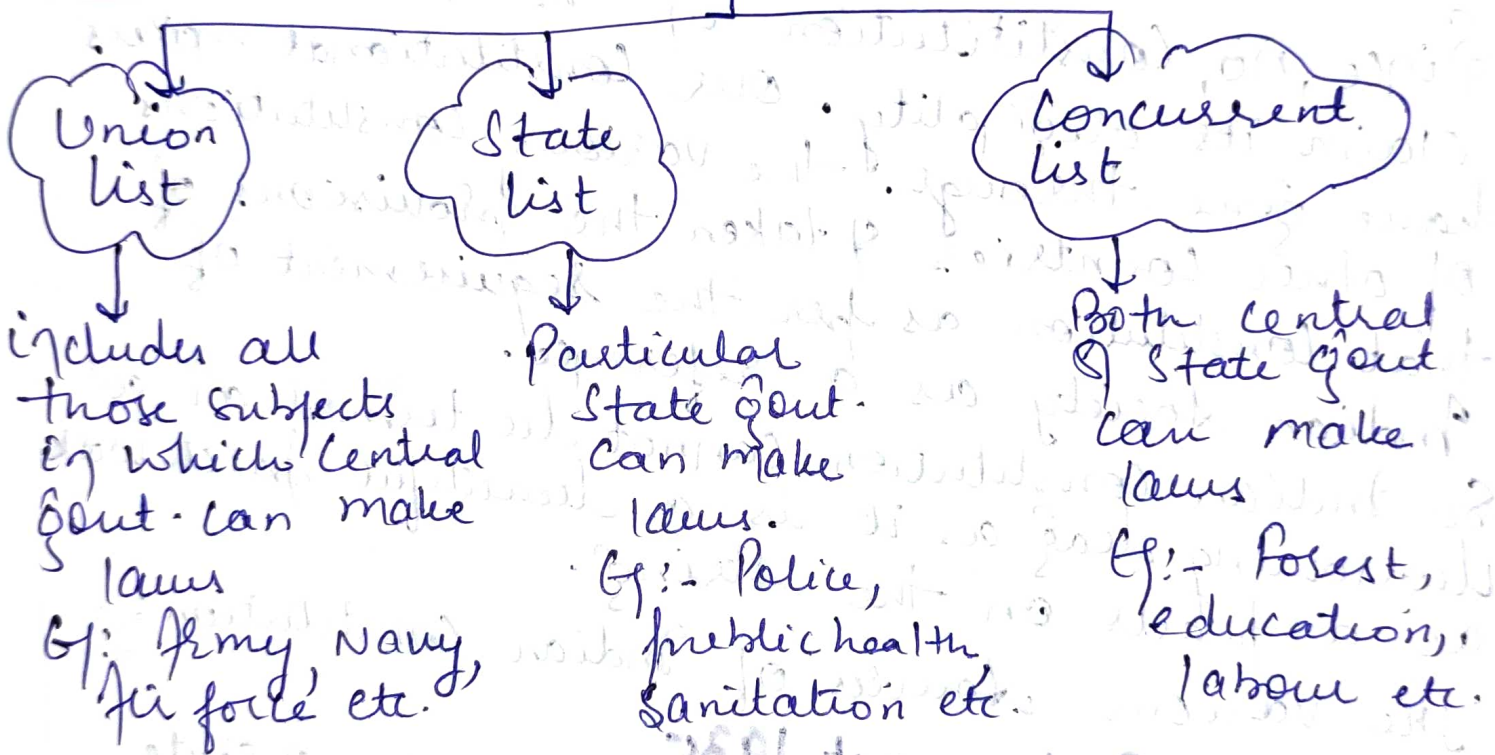
3<sup>rd</sup> Schedule :- It consist of oath & affirmation for union ministers of India, parliament candidates, MP, SC Judges, CAG, State ministers, State legislation election candidates & members, High Court Judges.

4<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It contains the provisions in relation to allocation of seats for States & UT in Rajya Sabha.

5<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It contains provisions related to administration & control of Schedule areas & Schedule tribes.

6<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It contains provisions of administration & control of tribal areas of Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura, Mizoram.

7<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It consists of 3 lists



8<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It talks about 22 official languages recognized by constitution of India.

9<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It deals with State acts & regulations that deals with land reforms, like abolition of Zamindari system.

10<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It contains provisions relating to disqualification of MP & State legislative assembly on the grounds of defection.

11<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- It contains the provisions that specify the power & authority & responsibility of Panchayats. It has 29 matters.

12<sup>th</sup> Schedule :- Deals with powers, authority & responsibilities of Municipalities. It has 18 matters in it.
