Ans- The Indian National Congress (INC) was estb by A.O Hume, a retired civil servant, in year 1885.

The INC was different from Pre-INC political organisations in many aspects.

Some of these were:-

- i) Pre-INC organisations were regional in character.
- ii) They were set up with basic demands like administrative and educational reforms.
- iii) They were dominated mainly by wealthy and aristocratic classes.

INC - An All India Organisation:-

The first four sessions of congress:-

• I Session - In year 1885 was organised in Bombay region of the country. The session was headed by W.C. Banerjee (President of the session) who was a Hindu from Calcutta region.

• II Session - In year 1886 organised in Calcutta, which is in East of the country. The session was headed by Dadabhai Nauroji who was a Parsi from Bombay region.

• III Session - In year 1887 organised in Madras, ^{Bombay} whose president was Badrudin Tyabji and he was the 1st muslim to be a president. He was from Allahabad region.

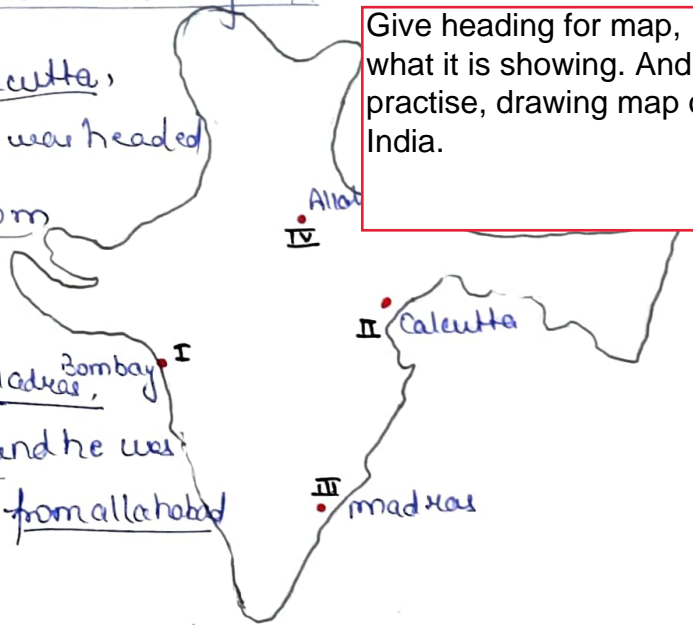
• IV Session - In year 1888 organised in Allahabad which is North region. President of the session was George Yule who was a 1st foreigner (Christian) to be a president. He was stayed at Madras.

If we see at the four sessions, it is clear that the West, East, South and North region respectively. With different community leaders and who were from different places. This speciality of the congress made it to be called as All India Organisation.
