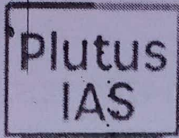
## Dharasana Satyagraha

India had been under the British rule for far too long & faced lot of problems. But one such that was most important in the freedom struggle was 'Salt act of 1882' acc to which only British Govt in India could manufacture & sell salt i.e. Salt monopoly. With the declaration of Poona Swaraj on Jan 26, 1930, the Congress Working Committee left it to Gandhi to decide how to launch civil disobedience movement but didn't agree to break salt law. On 12 March 1930, Gandhi started Dandi march to protest against steep tax the British levied on salt.

After this Gandhi planned a raid on Dharasana Salt works, which was 40 km south of Dandi, but was arrested before he could put that into action. But the march didn't stop; it was carried by Abbas Tyabji & Kasturba Gandhi, they were also arrested before reaching Dharasana & were sentenced to 3 months imprisonment. After their arrest, the peaceful agitation continued by Sarojini Naidu along with Maulana Abul Kalam Azad. They were encouraged by volunteers to try to get through the wire fence of salt works. On May 21, 1930 the police charged them severely.
