Q. What were the differences in approach ~~of or~~ between Gandhi and Bose in struggle for freedom of India - (150 words)

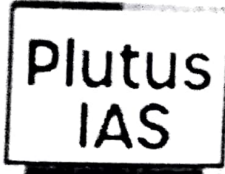

There were leaders such as Gandhiji & Subash Chandra Bose who emerged as a prominent figure in the freedom struggle. The struggle for Indian Independence, the participation of women in the mass struggles ~~highlights~~ some similarities between Gandhi & Bose.

They both differed in their notions, ideology, methods & path in the freedom struggle. Gandhiji followed the path of truth & non-violence while Subash Bose was a revolutionist who used the ways of violence. Gandhiji used the methods such as hunger strike, Satyagraha, marches etc while Bose took on to boycott of British goods, legislative councils etc, powerful speeches which was rooted in the minds of people.

Gandhiji was engaged in the constructive work such as establishment of school, national colleges, use of Indian goods such as khadi, while Bose was engaged in ~~assembling & regrouping~~ the troops, gaining help from countries such as Germany, Japan, USSR etc & formation of INA or Azad Hind Fauj out of India.

Their approaches were different but the final goal was the same - The independence of India. In 1942, Gandhi called him as a prince among the patriot as he was a leading figure and in 1944,
