

Q. The Naval Mutiny was the last nail in the Coffin of British Colonial aspiration.

With the ~~wake~~ upsurge of nationalistic feeling among masses, the Imperial rule was started being challenged. The 1905 Swadeshi and Boycott movement marked the start. Emergence of Gandhi and launch of Non-cooperation movement in 1919 saw popular participation and unity. The 1929 Lahore session's declaration of demand for "Poorna Swaraj" made Indian intentions clear. Later, the Civil disobedience of 1932 and Quit India movement of 1942 weakened the British Rule completely.

1) The attempts of Indian National Army in 1943-44 aided the military consciousness of nationalism. Subsequently in ~~Feb 1946~~ <sup>Feb 1946</sup>, the Royal Indian Navy (RIN) movement mutiny broke out.

2) The Naval Ratings of HMS Talwar went on strike against:

- 1) Bad food.
- 2) Racial discrimination.
- 3) INA trials

3) Parallely ongoing communal riots also made British rule difficult.

4) The RIN mutiny, along with sympathy of Royal Indian air force and Indian National army depicted the helplessness ~~of~~ end of colonial rule in India.

These movements were enough to oust British rule. In 1946, Viceroy Lord Wavell said, "Our time in India is limited and our power to control events almost gone". Hope for independence and numerous sacrifices led to independence of India in 1947.
