Zulfikar Khan.

- Introduced IZARAC (revenue farming)



Farrukhsiyar (1713 - 1719)

- He killed Jahander Shah with the help of Sayyid Brothers
- 1st king to be killed by Nobels.



Rafi-Ud-Darjad (Feb 28' - 4' June 1719)

- Ruled for shortest period among mughals



Rafi-ud-Daula (June 6' - Sept 17' 1719)

- Made king by sayyid brothers.



Muhammad Shah (1719 - 1748)

- Made king by Sayyad brothers

- Was called as Lungeela

- Killed Sayyad Brothers.
