Reasons for Mughal Decline

1. Aurangzeb : Religious and deccan policy
 ↳ Religious policy agitated the Jats, marathas and Rajput
 ↳ Deccan policy kept his away from Capital

2. Later Mughals
 ↳ weak successor
 ↳ Absence of definitive law of Succession

3. External Factors
 ↳ Invasion of Nader Shah & Abdali.

4. Internal Factors
 ↳ Too vast an empire - difficult to handle by a weak successor
 ↳ Jagirdari Crisis - Degeneration of Noble and ruler
 ↳ Economic decline due to endless war and stagnation in agri-culture.

- ↳ Jagirdari and Zamindari Crisis
5. Rise of Regional Aspirations
↳ Bengal, Mysore, Awadh,
Hyderabad etc.
6. Advent of European

How it helped British?

1. These factors exposed the vulnerability of the Mughal authority
2. The weakness of the empire led the english east company to assert their authority
3. It was easy to divide the rulers of Indian subcontinent and rule over them
4. It made inevitable about the fall of India to EIC.
